

OUTBREAK DISINFECTION PROTOCOL

During this current outbreak the following cleaning and disinfecting protocols will be in effect as of today (April 6, 2020) and will be reviewed at the end of April 2020.

Arcus is requesting that all homes use bleach as their method of disinfection during this time. If you have a supply of Action DSC then you may continue to use that, following the policy for disinfection solution.

- All surfaces must be cleaned with a detergent or soap and water before disinfection (Bleach is solely a disinfectant).
- A 1:10 solution of regular household (unscented) bleach is appropriate for daily use:
 - o 62ml (¼ cup) bleach + 562ml (2 ¼ cups) water
 - o 250ml (1 cup) bleach + 2250ml (9 cups) water
- Bleach solutions should be stored in an opaque (non-see through) container and must be made fresh at a minimum of every 24 hours. (Bleach rapidly degrades in the presence of light and when mixed with water). Label your bottle with the date.
- **DO NOT** mix bleach with any other cleaner
- After applying the bleach solution, surface must be wet for 3-5 minutes and allowed to air dry.
 - o For surfaces like counters, taps, door handles use a spray bottle
 - o For floors use a bucket
