



LEVEL 1 ISOLATION

WHERE

- in a client's home
- a home that Arcus provides care in OR that an Arcus client has visited

WHO

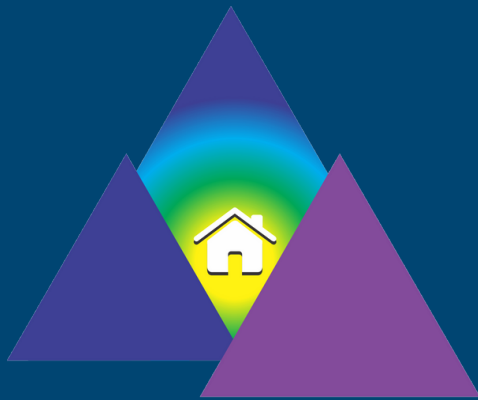
- client
- staff
- family member

WHY

- staff, client or family MAY have been exposed but ARE NOT DISPLAYING SYMPTOMS

CONTROLS

- site specific scrubs and shoes
- gloves for handling any client items that may have been in contact with bodily fluids
- if no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes



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LEVEL 2 ISOLATION

WHERE

- Arcus Facility

WHO

- client

- staff

WHY

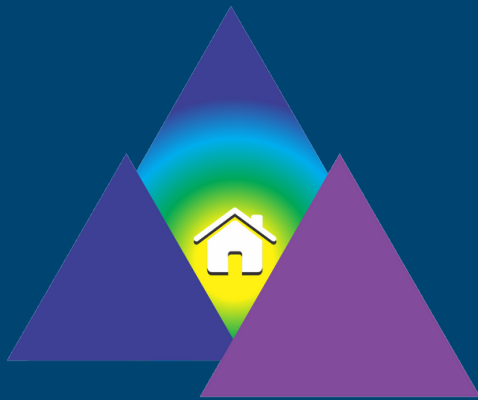
- staff or client MAY have been exposed, MAY be incubating, MAY be shedding but ARE NOT DISPLAYING SYMPTOMS

CONTROLS

- site specific scrubs and shoes

- gloves for handling any client items that may have been in contact with bodily fluids

- if no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes



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LEVEL 3 ISOLATION

terminate as directed

WHERE

- Arcus facility

WHO

- 1. staff member, exhibiting symptoms and is now in self-isolation (not exposed to a contact)
- 2. staff member was exposed to a positive case of COVID-19 and is now in self-isolation.

WHY

- staff was in the Arcus home, may have exposed staff and clients to COVID-19

CONTROLS

- site specific scrubs and shoes
- gloves for handling any client items that may have been in contact with bodily fluids
- if no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes
- masks at all times



LEVEL 3P ISOLATION

terminate after 14 days of all staff and clients being non-symptomatic

WHERE

- Arcus facility

WHO

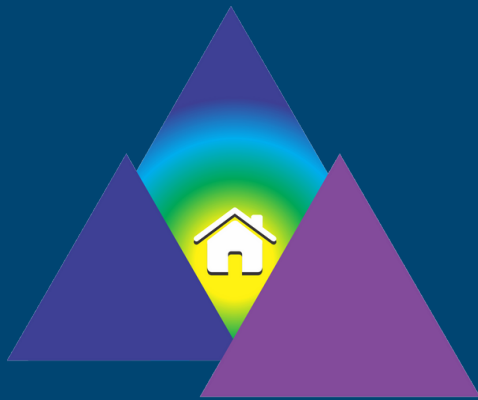
- Staff member, exhibiting symptoms, tested POSITIVE for COVID-19 and is now in self-isolation

WHY

- Staff was in the Arcus home, may have exposed staff and clients to COVID-19

CONTROLS

- Site-specific scrubs and shoes
- Gloves at all times
- If no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes
- Disposable masks at all times
- Gowns over scrubs at all times
- Face shields at all times
- Visits are on HOLD until cleared by Public Health



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LEVEL 4 ISOLATION

terminate after 14 days of all staff and clients being non-symptomatic

WHERE

—● Arcus facility

WHO

—● a client that is exhibiting symptoms

WHY

—● client in the Arcus home, may have exposed staff and clients to COVID-19

CONTROLS

—● site specific scrubs and shoes

—● gloves at all time

—● if no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes

—● disposable masks at all times

—● gown while in contact with client(s)

—● face shields at all times

—● Visits are on HOLD until a NEGATIVE Covid-19 test is confirmed



LEVEL 5 ISOLATION

terminate after 14 days of all staff and clients being non-symptomatic

WHERE

● Arcus facility

WHO

● a client that is suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19

WHY

● client in the Arcus home, may have exposed staff and clients to COVID-19

CONTROLS

● site specific scrubs , shoes, and gowns at all times

● gloves at all times

● if no scrubs, bring separate change of clothes

● Disposable procedure masks at all times

● all clients in the home contained to their bedroom

● face shields at all times

● NO VISITORS until cleared by Public Health
